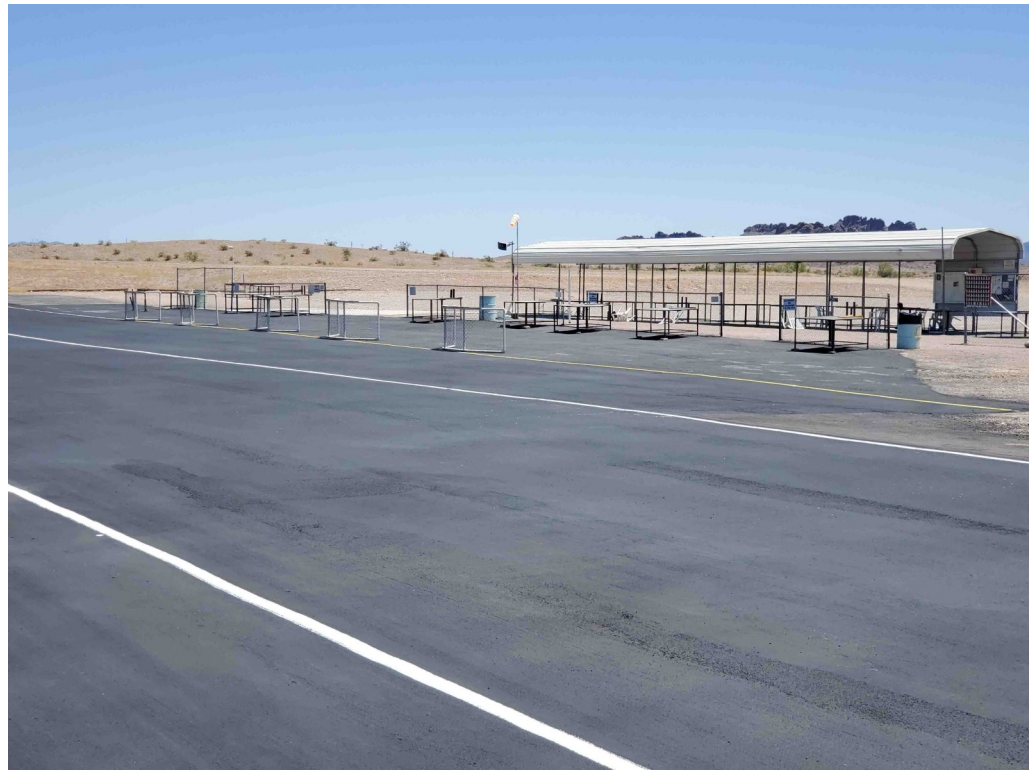


First, I want to apologize for this Newsletter being 2 months late. With all the activities and repairs going on, time just got away from me.

The runway resurfacing project did not go as smoothly (pun intended) as we had planned. After the main resurfacing, a month later we needed repairs which only made matters worse. After a fair amount of complaining our vendor felt the only way to appease us was to seal coat the runway for free, saving us \$7,000. Seal coating filled in the imperfections and gave us a nice black finish. We also decided to have a local company seal coat the pit area which was not in the original contract. The runway and pit area look great and the runway is as smooth as it has ever been.



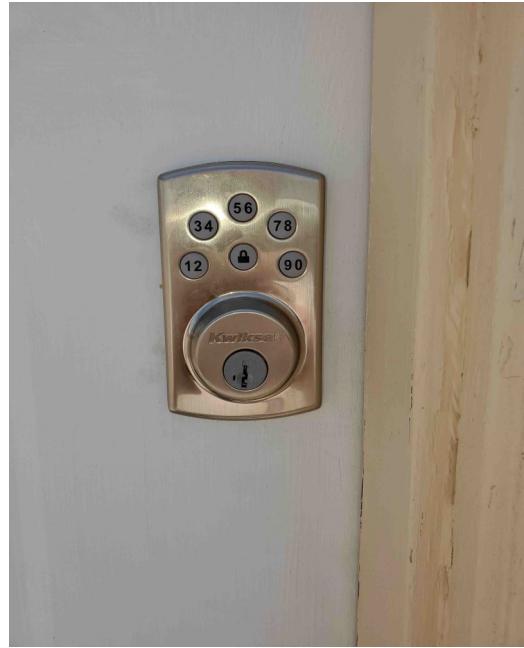
Fast Line, a local LHC company seal coated the pit area. The boundary lines were painted by our members.



As all of you know COVID-19 has thrown us into a bit of a tailspin. As part of Lake Havasu Parks and Recreation Services we had to make some city mandated changes. The city shut down all public restrooms. Since we are open to the public our restrooms had to be locked, except for club members use. In keeping with the order to limit groups of 10 or more we received permission to close our property to spectators. We purchased a sign stating, "Temporary Closing Only Club Members Allowed" The sign is on the left-hand side of the front gate. For now, when we open the right-side gate, we leave the left side gate closed showing the new sign. Please remember last one on the property is responsible to lock the gate.



Regarding our restrooms - the city is opening public restrooms, but they have a new procedure for disinfecting them on a more frequent basis. Unfortunately, we do not have the resources to clean the restrooms on a set schedule. Since we are unable to disinfect by city standards, we are keeping the restrooms closed to the public and have installed combination locks on the doors. To use the restrooms, you punch in the same code as the front gate and push the image of the lock on the keypad after you input the code. When you leave you simply push the lock button.
